FROM THE DESK OF PRESIDENT







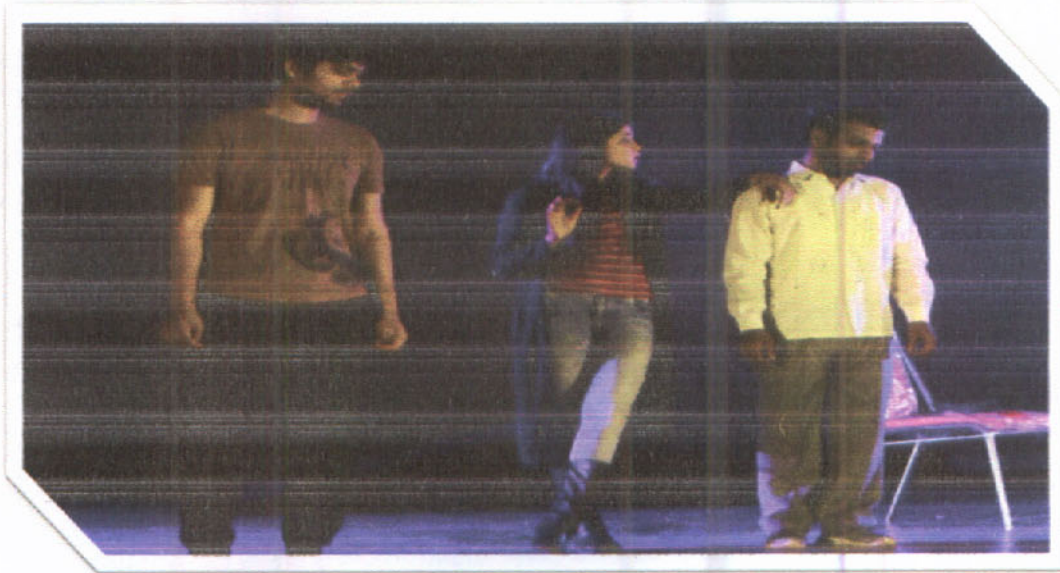
➤ 2ND FARIDABAD THEATRE FESTIVAL

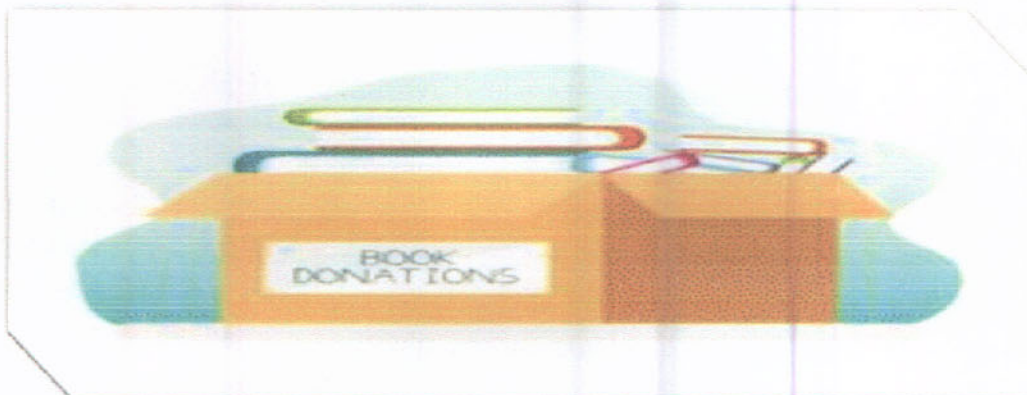
In this way, the plays of six different themes in three days kept the audience engaged. The actors were also honored at the end of all the plays.

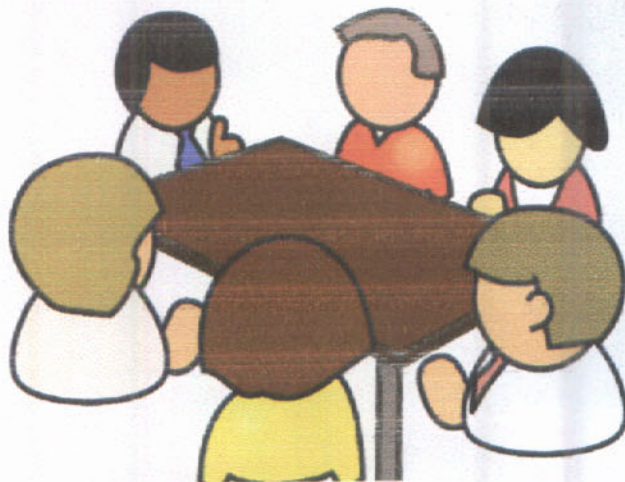




